



**Addendum No. 1**

Gilbert-Stephenson Park – Fencing**

1. **Question:** It is currently taking 8-10 weeks to receive materials for projects once they are ordered. The Invitation to Bid states that the project must be completed within 60 days following receipt of the Notice to Proceed. Can this requirement be changed to accommodate the long lead time on materials?

**Answer:** Section 1.2.3 shall be modified and shall now read as follows:

Upon receipt of the notice of award, the awarded contractor(s) shall order all materials needed for the project within seven calendar days of the notice of award. Proof of the orders, including, but not limited to, detailed invoicing, must be provided to the City upon request within seven days of receipt of the notice of award. Upon receipt of materials, the awarded contractor(s) will have 35 calendar days to complete the project as specified in this Invitation to Bid. This includes five weather days, should they be necessary.

2. **Question:** Do these specifications contain a section on liquidated damages?  
**Answer:** No.
3. **Question:** Can SS 20 pipe be used for top rails in the chain link fence installation instead of SS 40 pipe?  
**Answer:** No. As specified in Section 1.1.2 Posts/Rails, all corner posts, line posts, and top rails shall be SS 40 pipe.
4. **Question:** If one contractor is awarded Option A – Ornamental Aluminum and Chain Link Fencing and a different contractor is awarded Option B – Block Pillars, will the contractors have to coordinate work efforts?  
**Answer:** Should the contract be split between multiple contractors, the awarded contractors shall communicate, coordinate work tasks, and work cooperatively to ensure the project is successful and acceptable as deemed by the City. Both contractors will be required to complete the project in the time frame specified by the City.
